- 43 Tempranillo, Coviñas 2008 £17.50
Heaps of ripe juicy freshness with deceptively smooth flavours of bright cherry and blackcurrant fruit.
- 44 Rioja Reserva, Vina Alcorta 2005 £27.00
Cherry-red with ruby red hues, bright and clear, with good depth of colour.

South Africa

- 46 Pinotage, Cape Crown 2008 £20.00
A medium-bodied red wine made from the only grape-type uniquely South African. Ripe raspberry fragrances, with aromas of almonds. A well-balanced wine ready to be enjoyed on its own or with red meats

Australia

- 47 Shiraz, Gumdale 2008 £23.00
Classic black berry, cedar and cassis character, with a complex finish of mint, pepper and eucalyptus.

New Zealand

- 48 Pinot Noir, Overstone, Hawkes Bay, New Zealand 2008/09 £31.50
A stunning New World Pinot with excellent fruit concentration offering cherry and red berry flavours with layers of spice. A well structured wine with good length and complexity.

Argentina

- 49 Tempranillo/Malbec, Finca Beltran 2009 £19.50
Bursting with cherries and red fruits with a hint of spice. Tenderly crafted from certified organically grown grapes.

Chile

- 51 Merlot, Vina Santa Monica 2003 £20.50
Intense red fruit and floral nose with overtones of cassis, morello cherry, plum and strawberry. Full body, supple tannins, round and lasting finish.

White Wines

France

- 10 Chardonnay, Guillaume Aurele 2008 £18.50
This yellow bright Chardonnay, gives a wine with fine aromas of exotic fruit, passion fruit, mango and pink grapefruit. Good length with dry fruit hints.
- 11 Picpoul de Pinet, Guillaume Aurele 2008 £20.50
This very distinctive under rated grape proves to be the perfect accompaniment to seafood. The wine is clean and refreshing with crisp, zesty notes; a beautifully refined wine with a delicate minerality.
- 17 Chablis, Pascal Bouchard 2008 £35.50
A wonderfully full wine with tropical fruit flavours. Clean, fresh with perfectly balanced acidity and with great length.
- 15 Pouilly Fumé, Dominique Pabiot 2007 £37.00
A classic Loire Sauvignon Blanc which means gooseberry, passion fruity, lime and honey aromas. The finish is refreshingly clean yet not overly acidic.
- 18 Ladoix Blanc "les Boisvelles", Pierre André 2007 £50.00
Softness and finesse are the main characteristics of these wines. This wine is nutty, buttery and spicy with overtones of honey, cinnamon and vanilla. Deliciously dry and rich.

Italy

- 19 Pinot Grigio, Fabiano 2009 £18.50
This lively, refreshing wine has a wonderful apple aroma and a typically smooth palate brimming with ripe peach character.
- 20 Gavi DOC, Gioglio Cichero 2006 £32.00
A fragrant, slightly floral aroma of lilies of the valley. Green apple notes on the palate – a well made crisp and clean wine.

Spain

- 22 Rioja Blanco, Gomez de Segura 2008 £24.50
This vibrant dry, flavoursome and youthful white Rioja is extremely well structured with an elegant and lingering finish.
- 21 Albariño, Aires de Arosa 2007 £32.00
A medium bodied dry wine, with intense aromas of peaches and pears and a gently spiced palate.

England

- 23 Mumford's Medium Dry, Bath 2006 £18.95
Aromatic and fruit nose (lemon and rose petal) followed on the palate by lightly honeyed flavours and a clean zingy acidity – produced within 10 miles of this hotel!

South Africa

- 25 Chenin Blanc, Cape Crown 2008/09 £18.50
This dry-styled Chenin is bright, fresh and clean with the added fruitiness created by this award-winning single estate.
- 14 Gewurztraminer, Bergsig Estate 2005 £21.50
Careful handling and winemaking reveals a refined rose petal & lychee character that this variety shows at its elegant best.

Australia

- 26 Colombar/Chardonnay, Emu Rise 2007 £22.50
A delightful fresh citrus nose is supported by a rounded and clean palate with pear and melon fruit flavours backed up by excellent acidity.
- 27 Verdelho, Tullumbra Estate 2007/08 £24.50
Though still quite rare, Verdelho is the 'in' grape Down Under among lovers of smart whites. Enticing aromas of pineapple, peach and freshly mown grass with crisp acidity on the finish.

New Zealand

- 28 Sauvignon Blanc, Overstone 2009 £28.00
A crisp, light, classic expression of Marlborough Sauvignon Blanc with concentrated flavours of gooseberry, citrus and melon. A stunning example of cool-climate New Zealand winemaking.

Chile

- 29 Sauvignon Blanc, El Otro 2009 £17.50
This charming dry Sauvignon Blanc is highly aromatic with citrus and herb overtones ending on a persistent, clean and fresh finish.

- 30 Cabernet Sauvignon Rosé, Surazo 2007 £17.50
Delicate and complex aroma, with cherry and violet notes. Dry, with a very good body and a persistent floral finish.

Italy

- 31 Pinot Grigio Blush, Fabiano 2008 £19.50
A pretty salmon pink colour, slightly sweet with a fresh taste and a crisp acidity.....incredibly refreshing and very moreish!

Red Wines

France

- 32 Merlot, Guillaume Aurele 2008 £18.50
A beautiful dark red colour, and offers intense aromas of ripe blackcurrant, blueberry and Provençal herbs. Generous and silky in the mouth, with plump fruit and hints of spice.
- 33 Pinot Noir, Guillaume Aurele 2009 £20.50
Autumnal aromas of blackberries and blackcurrants, this soft, elegant style of Pinot Noir is full of vibrant strawberry and raspberry fruit flavours.
- 34 Côtes du Rhône, L'Escarpe 2007 £22.00
Deep Garnet-red in colour with aromas of blackcurrants and blackberries. A good balance between fruity and robust flavours.
- 35 Morgon, Domaine Éric Collonge 2006 £29.00
Brilliant garnet in colour a spicy nose with good intensity and hints of peach. Well structured with flavours of cherries.
- 36 Bourgogne Pinot Noir, Pierre Janny 2007 £30.00
Good intensity of bouquet with suggestions of cherries. A gentle and smooth wine to be enjoyed when young. Fresh and spicy finish.
- 37 Chateau La Tonnelle, Cru Bourgeois 2006 £35.50
A smooth and fruity wine with a delicate oaky taste. Predominantly Cabernet Sauvignon, soft tannins makes this very pleasant drinking.
- 38 Château La Pointe Bouquey, Saint Emilion 2007/08 £38.50
A stylish wine from a very well respected estate. Blackcurrants, a hint of oak, mint, and tobacco. This has developed a rustic nose that is rich and full yet is also turning softer and mature.
- 39 Châteauneuf du Pape, Domaine Jean Deydier et Fils 2005 £56.50
A powerful and concentrated wine with spice and pepper underpinning the seductive intense sweet black fruit.

Italy

- 41 Montepulciano d'Abruzzo, Orsola 2008 £19.50
Made from 100% Montepulciano d'Abruzzo grapes. A well-balanced red, soft and light wine with a plummy, youthful style.
- 42 Valpolicella Classico Superiore 'Ripasso', Fratelli Farina 2005/06 £30.00
A red wine with striking peppery fruit, smooth and soft in tannin, and pleasant concentration of flavours and aromas.
